Colorfastness to Crocking

Test Method: The test was conducted in accordance with AATCC Test Method 8, *Colorfastness to Crocking: Crockmeter Method*. This test method is designed to determine the amount of color transferred from the surface of colored textile materials to other surfaces by rubbing. It is applicable to textiles made from all fibers in the form of yarn or fabric whether dyed, printed or otherwise colored. The test is conducted under both dry and wet conditions. Colorfastness rating is made using the AATCC Evaluation Procedure 3, *Chromatic Transference Scale*, a numeric rating based on AATCC *Terminology for Subjective Rating Processes* where 5 = negligible or no crocking, 4 = slight, 3 = noticeable, 2 = considerable, and 1 = much crocking.

Material Tested: The client submitted a sample of coated fabric identified as **702503 Keri**.
